What can music APIs do?

- Provide data about artists, tracks, albums
 - MusicBrainz, LyricWiki, Yahoo Music
- Provide concert information
 - o Gruvr, JamBase
- Identify music based on sound fingerprints
 - MusicDNS
- Access your streaming music
 - o Rhapsody, Pandora
- Share/contribute with other listeners
 - o Last.FM, OpenStrands, iLike

MusicBrainz

http://tinyurl.com/mbrainz-api

- Unique ID's for each artist, track, album, label
- Example Searching for artist "Rolling Stones"
- Use MBID:
 - o http://musicbrainz.org/ws/1/artist/[MBID]?type=xml
 - o Requires knowing the MBID!
- Use artist name:
 - o http://musicbrainz.org/ws/1/artist/?query=[ARTIST_NAME]&type=xml
 - o Returns "Rolling Stones", "Rolling Stock", "Thirty Stones", etc Uh oh!

Community keeps the music data up to date -- great source of music metadata!

Last.FM

http://www.last.fm/api/intro

Great for...

- tagging artists/music
- finding out what other people are listening to
- "scrobbling" your own music

Uses MusicBrainz IDs!

Pandora

http://tinyurl.com/pandora-api (Sorry, it's just a JS file...)

Unsupported! Undocumented! Unpredictable!

Uses a .swf file that triggers "events" in Javascript listeners:

- SongPlayed, SongPaused, etc.
- Passes JSON object to callback function

```

Only a few Pandora mashups in the wild...
